# Dear Sir/Madam, Dear teachers from Poland,

Brandenburg welcomes new teachers! We offer attractive working conditions and recruit 1,200 to 1,500 teachers throughout the year. If you're interested in working in the teaching profession in the State of Brandenburg, we'd be happy to provide you with information and help you further.

# We are looking for the following in particular:

Primary school teachers (years 1-6), but also for higher years, especially in the subjects of mathematics, art, music, physics, biology, chemistry, English, computer science and sports, as well as for special educational needs. As a teacher who has been trained in Poland, you are cordially invited to apply for these positions. An important requirement for employment is a very good knowledge of German.

Almost 200 of your colleagues work in our state in schools in the border region, but also in Potsdam or other places near Berlin. Our greatest need is in the towns and communities close to the border. Would you like to know more?

#### We offer

A **secure job** and **a very good salary** (currently a minimum of 3,523 euro gross per month when working full time). This increases significantly the more professional experience you have (years of employment). And freedom of movement within the European Union means working in the state of Brandenburg is easy.

Even if you have only studied one teaching subject, you can join the teaching profession in the state of Brandenburg on a permanent basis after 13 months, with a clear prospect of a fixed contract. We also encourage on-the-job training. The effort involved is worthwhile, since Polish citizens can also be employed as **civil servants** if they meet the other requirements of Civil Service Law.

What else do we offer? With a population of around 2.6 million, Brandenburg, bordered by the Oder river to the east and the Elbe river to the west, has a great deal to offer: beautiful, old and extensively renovated towns, a largely excellent infrastructure, wonderful cultural sites, 3,000 lakes and a vast unspoilt natural landscape. The choice of nursery schools and kindergartens is very good almost everywhere. And in our midst lies the largest city in the middle of Brandenburg: the vibrant metropolis of Berlin.
